About: Journey Church has an operating budget of \$1.9M and provides two in-person Sunday services (9 and 11 a.m.) with live online streaming at both hours. Journey places a high value on the Sunday morning experience. Worship is exceptional, preaching is biblically-based, Christ-centered and applicable to the complexities of life. Journey has hosted hundreds of community-wide groups and events, including Family Promise of Gallatin Valley (an organization to eradicate homelessness) and TEDxBozeman.

This individual will recognize potential in others, encourage them to use their gifts, and place them into their "sweet spot" of ministry.
