Roane County services are offered via HD video of teaching at 9:30 and 11 a.m. Bearden's are offered at 10 a.m. via HD video of teaching. Two Rivers Church lives its four core values of being Gospel-centered, Word-dependent, Spirit-empowered and Relationally connected. Staff who thrive here work hard, play hard and have fun doing both.
