The Church




Denomination: non-denominational

Be aligned with Oak Pointe's core beliefs (found at https://www.oakpointe.org/about/beliefs/); Doctorate (D-Min, PhD, or ThD) is preferred, a Master of Divinity degree is a minimum; Prior ordination or in pursuit of ordination; A minimum of 10 years ministry experience with multiple years of senior leadership and team development in a multi-staff setting in a larger church context (>750 attendees) that includes preaching, collaboration, delegation, oversight and development of paid staff and unpaid volunteers; Exceptional Bible-based preaching, teaching and communication skill; a genuine passion for the gospel and a deep love for scripture; Mature faith and wisdom that has been tested and proven through experience and intimacy with Jesus, resulting in an intimate, Spirit-led faith; Cross cultural and long/short term missions experience; Pastoral leader that instills confidence and shepherds his flock.
