# The Church

About – With a mission to serve and glorify God by being and making disciples for Jesus Christ, Victory offers worship services four times each weekend: Saturdays at 4 p.m. and Sundays at 8 and 9:30 a.m. in a space that is modern, bright and welcoming. A contemporary 11 a.m. service is offered between January and Easter. At all other times the worship style is traditional, and the beautiful pipe organ sets a tone for worship that is celebrated and valued. Grounded in a strong evangelical theological and doctrinal framework, sermons stand as a beacon of solid, Bible-based preaching. Victory is served by a talented staff of 11, and governed by a Church Council of six men and women, plus the Senior Pastor who is also a voting member. Financially, Victory is in a solid position with a budget of \$1.2M.

#### The Candidate



Victory would like to call a strong, confident pastoral leader with mature faith and clear theological convictions that align with LCMC. A seasoned preacher, this pastor will be a gifted and skillful communicator of God's Word, teaching biblical truth that is relatable and memorable, using relevant stories to help illustrate and bring home the point. The ideal candidate will possess some business sensibility and an ability to fundraise that will help Victory continue to support its mission, budget effectively and practice wise stewardship of finances and resources. As the leader of a large, multi-faceted congregation, it is essential the candidate work well with others and have experience leading and developing a high-caliber team. Being able to delegate and empower others to contribute their best will ensure Victory is operating at its peak level.

Located in the East Valley of Phoenix, AZ, Mesa is home to 500,000 residents, including many retirees and snowbirds from across the Midwest and Canada who spend their winters in its beautiful climate.
