Ascent is a growing congregation just north of Colorado Springs. Ascent has been on the front lines of this reality, and for the last five years has partnered with schools for suicide prevention. This year, 17 schools will be getting resources raised through the Run4Hope 5k the church hosts annually. Teaching through a biblical lens while still being able to connect with students who are hurting or questioning is critical.
