Additional responsibilities include teaching as needed throughout the calendar year, mobilizing the body toward mission fulfillment and providing pastoral care for those in times of need. Redemption Hill Church is a theologically conservative congregation embracing Reformed theology and an evangelistic posture toward the city. The congregation will welcome a leader whose walk with Jesus is life-giving, positive and action oriented. As a member of a staff team who cares for each other, he will embrace working together to reach more people for Christ.

About: The church worships weekly in two similar services at 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., with an online service accessible during the early service. The services feature contemporary music, weekly communion and an expository-style message designed to correctly teach scripture while helping congregants understand their role in a post-Christian setting. Children's programming is offered in each service. The church is financially stable and is looking to move into permanent facilities through the program they initiated called Dwell.
