<u>Overview</u>

Plymouth Covenant Church (PCC) in Plymouth, Minnesota is ready to call an experienced, relational and collaborative Lead Pastor to join them on their journey toward their newly articulated vision "to see our church, city, and world encounter Jesus and be transformed forever."

<u>The Big Idea</u>



There is so much about this Lead Pastor opportunity that feels compelling. The church has a strong external drive and numerous ministries that speak to their desire to be a light for the Gospel. They affirm their mission to be followers of Jesus who go and make disciples through the power of the Holy Spirit. PCC is unified as a theologically conservative congregation. They hold a high view of Scripture and share common fundamentals of the faith including traditional Christian views on human sexuality, marriage and life. The incoming Lead Pastor will enter into a spiritually-vital congregation that loves Jesus and craves depth and authenticity in relationships and biblical teaching. But the leadership transitions of the past several years have taken a toll. Ministries and staff feel somewhat compartmentalized and siloed; staff tend to operate with greater independence than ideal. Increasing the rhythms of collaboration, advanced planning and assessment of ministry effectiveness will help PCC optimize and maximize its potential. Their new vision is affirmed by leadership, but is only beginning to be understood by congregants. The Lead Pastor will be called on to communicate it inspirationally and effectively orchestrate the team to guide its implementation.

About: PCC's three weekend worship services at 5:30 p.m. on Saturdays and 9 and 11 a.m. on Sunday mornings are authentic and engaging. The musical style is modern, and leaders effectively help to focus and prepare people to hear God's Word. The preaching is grounded in Scripture, Word-based and relevant. Messages are designed to speak to the whole person, across age ranges and levels of spiritual maturity. The church also offers a video venue with a traditional worship style called The Connection, which meets in a smaller auditorium on-site called The Refinery at 10:30 a.m. each Sunday.

The value for depth in biblical teaching is high at PCC, and this pastor will have an opportunity to provide sound, relevant biblical instruction that helps congregants navigate the murky, often choppy waters of current culture in a way that remains true to Scripture and biblical principles. PCC will respond well to a relational Lead Pastor who understands how to lead a complex, multi-faceted organization, but with a pastoral heart. The church is looking for a team leader who enjoys collaborating with others to develop and maximize the potential of the ministries. PCC anticipates a pastor who will build upon the good foundation in the church, celebrating, honoring and respecting the work of those who came before, shaping and aligning the future direction with the church's values, mission and vision. As a multi-generational congregation, PCC needs a pastor who can effectively communicate with people of different ages and stages of spiritual maturity, fostering a culture of unity and connectivity throughout the church.
